# GÉRARD BERTRAND

## L'ART DE VIVRE LES VINS DU SUD

*Gérard Bertrand is one of the most outstanding winemakers in the South of France, where he is known locally as the 'King of the Languedoc'. Formerly the IWC Red Winemaker of the Year & Wine Enthusiast European Winery of the Year, he has been named 'Green Personality of the Year' 2020 for his commitment to Biodynamic production across his portfolio.*

### WHITE

**Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc-Roussillon, France, 2019.....** £34

*Picpoul Blanc has been an iconic grape in Languedoc since the 17th century. Produced in the town of Pinet, west of Marseilles, this dry & zesty wine epitomises the Mediterranean influence on the region*

**Chardonnay, Naturalys, Pays D'Oc, Languedoc-Roussillon, France, 2018 ...** £9 / £17 / £34

*Naturalys is a collection of Bertrand's wines produced from organic grapes with eco-friendly packaging and low carbon footprint. This Chardonnay is a smooth wine with notes of vanilla and exotic fruit.*

**Domaine de Cigalus 'Cigalus Blanc', Languedoc, France 2018 ...** £14 (125ml) / £75

*Domaine de Cigalus is Bertrand's homestead. It's hot, sunny days a stone's throw from the Mediterranean give it ideal conditions for the vineyard as well as its proprietor. All harvesting is done by hand and in accordance with solar and lunar cycle.*

### ROSÉ

**Clos du Temple, Cabrieres, Languedoc-Roussillon, 2019.....** £275

*Named the World's Best Rose 2020 at the Global Masters this truly exquisite rose bursts with notes of peach, spice and flora balanced with extraordinary aromatic freshness with a long elegant finish.*

### RED

**Mourvedre/Syrah, Saint Chinian, Languedoc-Roussillon, France, 2017.....** £33

*Saint Chinian is a village in the Languedoc which has grown vines since the Middle Ages and this long history presents a complex wine with notes of black fruit, cocoa and sweet spice.*

**Pinot Noir Domaine de l'Aigle, Aude, Languedoc-Roussillon, 2016.....** £13 / £24 / £47

*Bonelli's Eagles are a protected species whose nests overlook the Domaine de l'Aigle in the Pyrenean foothills. The altitude & oceanic climate combine to produce a wine fresh with raspberry and cranberry notes and exceptional structure*

**Clos d'Ora, Minervois la Laviniere, Languedoc-Roussillon, 2017.....** £47 (125ml) £275

*Considered to be Bertrand's Masterpiece Clos d'Ora took him and his team 17 years to perfect. A blend of Carignan, Syrah, Grenache and Mourvedre it is the pinnacle of Languedoc winemaking producing a deep & characterful wine with a full and intense palate.*

**Assyrtiko/Sauvignon Blanc, Ktima Biblia Chora, Macedonia, Greece, 2019**.....£8 / £48  
*Cool climate results in long, slow maturation of the grapes, intensifying flavour. The vineyard abides to strict ecological agricultural standards and all work is carried out by hand.*

**'The Mix Up' Volume I, Blackbook Winery, Battersea, England 2018** .....

£8 / £48  
*Housed under a disused Railway arch in the centre of the capital Blackbook source all their grapes from within 2 hours of their winery. They seek to blend innovation with tradition and put the grape & terrior at the forefront of their wines*

**'Back to Silence', Otella, Lugana, Veneto, Italy, 2017** .....

£11 / £64  
*No machinery whirring, just silence. This limited edition natural wine, made with no mechanical assistance at any part of the process, has magnificent golden, orange colour & intense aromas.*

**Hondarribia, Hiruzta Txakoli Winery, Basque, Spain, 2019**.....£6 / £36  
*Pre-2012 the production of Txakoli ("Cha-kho-lee") in Hondarribia was lost in the 1600s. Now thanks to the Hiruzta Project this naturally effervescent wine has been revitalised as the Basque icon that it is.*

**Ca'Rugate, Soave Classico Superiore 'Bucciato' Veneto, Italy, 2017**.....£9 / £50  
*A rich orange wine made exclusively from Garganega grapes which are left on their skins to give greater colour, tannin and depth of flavour to this internationally acclaimed Soave.*

- 'Hands of Time' Blend, Stag's Leap**, Napa, California, USA, 2017..... £12 / £70
- At the 1976 Judgment of Paris Stag's Leap beat established French producers in a blind tasting and disrupted the wine world. The grapes in this blend showcase the very best of Stag's Leap, and California.*

- Pax Aeterna 'Barossa Nouveau'**, Chaffey Bros, Barossa Valley, Australia, 2019..... £7 / £42
- Meaning 'Peace Eternal' this is a nod to the lack of machinery and therefore noise involved in the production of this wine. Grapes from 90-year old vines with an entirely modern look. Unfiltered and unfinned this is as natural as it comes*

- EDA Priorat**, Franck Massard, Catalunya, Spain, 2013 ..... £17 / £100
- Buying small plots from within the vineyards of larger producers, Massard uses traditional methods & biodynamic processes, prioritising quality over quantity, to prove what their land is capable of creating when directed towards quality over quantity.*

- Al Cantara, 'O' Scuru O'Scuru' Etna**, Sicily, Italy, 2016 ..... £12 / £70
- Mt. Etna's volcanic soil gives this wine an aromatic minerality. The vineyards are managed with biodynamic and organic principles of minimal intervention and all grapes are handpicked.*

- 'Tinto de la Casa' Malbec**, Matias Riccitelli, Mendoza, Argentina, 2018..... £10 / £55
- Matias Riccitelli is one of the most innovative young winemakers in Argentina. The use of whole-cluster fermentation gives a balance of rustic, green freshness with round, silky tannins.*
