Charles & Ruth Simpson have been making award-winning wines in the South of France since 2002. In 2012, attracted by the quality of the terroir & the opportunity to become part of one of the most dynamic wine producing regions in the world, they brought their expertise back to the UK, establishing Simpsons Wine Estate, situated in the Elham Valley, an unspoilt seam in the North Downs of Kent. Aspiring to produce the fines quality English wine, they planted 30 hectares of vineyards on the iconic chalk terroir of the North Downs & built a state-of-the-art gravity fed winery.
